
THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERPERSONS

The special meeting of the Mayor and Board of Alderpersons was held in the Courtroom at City Hall at 6:23 p.m. on Thursday, February 25, 2026. Mayor Mark A. Moore, Sr. presided.

Roll call was as follows:

The Invocation was given by Mayor Moore. Mr. D. Green led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The meeting was expanded to discuss a lease agreement for the property located at 615 Kammell Avenue on a motion by Mr. D. Green, seconded by Ms. Tappin, followed by a unanimous vote.

Mr. Charles Bradford, 1320 North Washington Street, opposed expanding the agenda to discuss any matters not already listed. He requested the Council seek an outside attorney or Mr. J. Rodney Pierre, to assist with the matter.

Ms. Rose Thompson, 120 Parkhurst, gave comments in opposition to locating the solar industry inside the city limits of Bastrop.

The Rules of Order were suspended to allow for public comments throughout the meeting on a motion by Mr. J. Green, seconded by Ms. Tappin, followed by a unanimous vote.

Mr. Willie Whitmore, 1013 Hood Street, stated KTRY media company will file a complaint with the Attorney General regarding the solar industry in the city.
