Mr. Charles Bradford, 1320 South Washington Street, requested more details of what is being spent in the budget.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:28 p.m. on a motion by Mr. Doaty, seconded by Ms. Tappin, followed by a unanimous vote.

THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERPERSONS

The special meeting of the Mayor and Board of Alderpersons was held in the Courtroom at City Hall at 7:35 p.m. on Monday, June 15, 2026. Mayor Mark A. Moore, Sr. presided.

Roll call was as follows:

The Invocation was given by Mr. Doaty. Mr. D. Green led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Attorney Ricky Smith advised the Council it would be asked to delete the budget resolutions due to needed corrections. The motion was made by Ms. Tappin, followed by a unanimous vote.

Mr. Charles Bradford, 1320 South Washington Street, made comments regarding changing procedures related to Occupational Licenses and the status of the McFee Bridge.

Mr. Bradford was allowed more time to speak on a motion by D. Green, seconded by Ms. Tappin, followed by a unanimous vote.

Robert Rules of Order were suspended to allow Ms. Kimberly Minniweather to speak regarding sale of adjudicated property, on a motion by Mr. J. Green, seconded by Ms. Tappin, followed by a unanimous vote.

Ms. Kimberly Minniweather with E & P Consulting provided information regarding the sale of adjudicated properties in the City.

Robert Rules of Order were restored on a motion by Mr. Loche, seconded by Mr. J. Green, followed by a unanimous vote.

The Council discussed Ordinance 26-4285, to amend the Occupational License revocation and procedures in Sec 13-9.

During discussion, Mr. D. Green left the meeting at 8:16 p.m. and returned at 8:22 p.m.
